



## PROSPECTS OF COOPERATION OF PREVENTION INSPECTORS WITH STATE BODIES AND INSTITUTIONS

**Abstract:** This article talks about the reforms implemented in the field of internal affairs during the years of independence, the prospects of the cooperation of prevention inspectors with state bodies and institutions. The article also analyzes the effective results of the cooperation of internal affairs prevention inspectors in the republic.

The reforms carried out in the years of independence laid the groundwork for democratization and liberalization of the judiciary, increasing its role and importance in protecting the rights and legal interests of citizens.

The place and role of crime prevention in the policy of combating crime carried out in our republic has significantly increased. The activity content of law enforcement agencies has completely changed. "A completely new system of crime prevention and crime fighting has been created. It is not only threatening to punish and dealing with the consequences of violations, but early prevention of illegal actions has become the most urgent task."<sup>1</sup>

Unprecedented large-scale reforms have been implemented to improve the system of internal affairs bodies. The main goal is to create a system that ensures reliable protection of citizens and society from terrorist attacks, subversive attacks, all forms of extremism, organized crime, and turning it into a reliable guarantee for the protection of individual rights and freedoms, public order, and the safety of citizens was placed<sup>2</sup>.

As a result of the implemented reforms, it is possible to continuously implement comprehensive measures to maintain public order and ensure security in residential areas, prevent violations, fight against crime, and ensure the execution of criminal sentences, the way of life of our people, a new system corresponding to the character, values and mentality of the internal affairs bodies was founded. In them, special attention was paid to establishing the activities of prevention inspectors who work together with the population in every neighborhood,



town, village and village, share their pains and sorrows, joys and worries, and are morally able to sympathize with them. During the past years, the legal, organizational-methodical, material-technical and personnel bases of the activities of the base points and cooperation based on them were formed. A number of normative and legal documents serving the organization and management of the activity of base points were adopted and implemented in the life of the society. As a result of this, a specific order and principles of organizing and managing their activities were decided. The material and technical base and infrastructure of the bases are improving year by year. A number of systematic works are being done to provide them with qualified specialist personnel and to improve the quality of work in this regard. As a result, today the base points have become the main place for maintaining peace and tranquility in neighborhoods, villages, towns and villages, ensuring law and order and public safety. In them, the employees of the relevant sectoral services of the internal affairs bodies provide services in close cooperation with each other, self-government bodies of citizens and other public structures, and other bodies of state power.

By meaningfully organizing the free time of minors and young people in the infrastructure of base points, raising their legal consciousness and culture, it is possible to prevent them from being influenced by various negative trends and committing crimes in neighborhoods. As a result of the work in this regard, over the past five years, crimes have not been allowed to be committed in an average of twenty percent of our country's neighborhoods. Also, as a result of the work carried out in cooperation, the share of extremely serious and serious types of crimes in all crimes is decreasing. In particular, in the composition of crimes committed in our republic in 2000, extremely serious crimes accounted for 11.7 percent and serious crimes for 30.6 percent. the indicators were 3.99 and 11.38 percent, respectively 3. Naturally, the base points operating in our republic play a big role in achieving such results. Today's dangers and threats, first of all, international terrorism, religious extremism, illegal migration, human trafficking, the increasing spread of ideas foreign to our people among the youth, must be brought to the attention of the internal affairs bodies in a timely manner to prevent them and to them. is setting new tasks for the elimination. This requires the effective organization and improvement of the activities of the internal affairs bodies of our country, in particular, their base points. In addition, the fact that the



measures for the prevention of offenses and the fight against crime are not directed to a specific destination and they are not comprehensively approached, as well as the fact that effective measures are not systematically developed to identify and eliminate the causes of offenses and the conditions that allow them to be committed. shows that there are a number of problems and shortcomings in the field of organization and management of the activity of base points.

With the adoption of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Internal Affairs Bodies" (September 16, 2016), the official definition of this concept was formed. In Article 15 of the law, the base points of the internal affairs bodies "are established to ensure the cooperation of the internal affairs bodies of the internal affairs departments (departments) of the districts and cities with the public and maintain public order in villages, hamlets and neighborhoods, the safety of citizens, the prevention of offenses, crime prevention. is the main lower link that directly ensures the fight against it" was defined. Therefore, the base points are considered the main lower link of district (city) internal affairs departments (departments), ensuring cooperation of internal affairs bodies with the public and public order in villages, villages and neighborhoods, citizen safety, crime prevention and is organized in order to directly ensure the fight against crime. Currently, social and legal control over crime in our republic is conditionally focused on three directions - 1) preventing the commission of crimes; 2) to ensure the inevitability of punishment for committed crimes; 3) it is divided into complex activities related to the implementation of activities aimed at ensuring the execution of the sentence determined by the court. Base points of internal affairs bodies are a unique system that has its own advantages with the opportunity to participate in the provision of all these directions.

Of course, cooperation of internal affairs prevention officers with state bodies and institutions is important for the full implementation of such tasks. In 2017-2021, the Strategy of Actions on the five priority directions of the development of the Republic of Uzbekistan envisages such tasks as "increasing the effectiveness of coordination of activities in the fight against crime and prevention of violations". This is the implementation of best practices, working methods and innovative technologies in the activity of the base points of the internal affairs bodies in our republic, improvement of their activities in terms of legal, organizational-methodical, material-technical aspects and provision of qualified personnel, mutual purpose based on the base points



requires increasing the efficiency of participation of public structures in the organization of cooperation.

Today, all employees of the field, regardless of their specialization, serving in the system of internal affairs bodies, should start their work from the neighborhood, cooperate with preventive (senior) inspectors, and rely on it. Because the majority of the population lives in the neighborhood. Everyone in the neighborhood knows each other, and the residents of this neighborhood know very well whether there are strangers or people with bad intentions. After all, "Increasing the qualifications and professional skills of prevention inspectors is one of the most important tasks. High professionalism, politeness, getting into people, being able to find a way to the hearts of young people, establishing strong relationships with family and school - these should be the main characteristics of every prevention inspector 4.

The main features of the cooperation of the prevention inspector with the officers of the criminal investigation and combating terrorism and extremism services: firstly, crimes against the person and property, organized crime and human trafficking, illegal circulation of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, prevention of terrorism and religious extremism, the reasons for their commission and identifying and eliminating the conditions that made them possible; secondly, in identifying persons hiding from investigative bodies, courts and investigations, searching for missing persons and unidentified corpses; thirdly, it is reflected in the quick and high-quality investigation of crimes committed in the area, the disclosure of unsolved crimes committed in the past years, as well as the determination of the causes and conditions of the occurrence of other unpleasant events and situations 5.

To conclude, the role and place of prevention inspectors in the implementation of crime prevention is incomparable. Therefore, improving the activities of prevention inspectors based on today's requirements and in accordance with the times, as well as ensuring positive results in the field of crime prevention, is of great importance in the development of society.
